Without his dedication to keeping track of everyone who had bowled in the BPDA, keeping the final average sheets for every year of the BPDA's existence, and making all kinds of notes, the publication of this book would have been impossible.

I would also like to thank Craig Rhinehart for creating most of the forms that are used in this book and for starting the History Book.

Finally, a special thank you to my wife, Carol, who allowed me to spend the time necessary to put this book together.

PREFACE

The Men's Division of the Baltimore Professional Duckpin Association was formed in 1961 out of necessity. Prior to 1961, the Men's Major League Franchises were owned by bowling establishment proprietors. Each proprietor, or someone delegated by the proprietor, selected his own team. As the years went on, problems developed. Teams became unbalanced in strength as the "Steinbrenners" of the times corralled the best bowlers on one, two or three of the teams. Also, it was difficult for new bowlers to break into the majors. New bowlers who had succeeded in the Minor Leagues had to depend on their personality or "knowing somebody" to get a chance in the Majors. By the end of the 1960 -61 season the situation was critical. The same teams were winning year after year. Major Leaguers who were past their prime could not be weeded out and promising newcomers had no place to go.

In September 1961 the Men's Division of the "Pro League" bowled its first unit match on the fourth floor of the Recreation Lanes on Howard Street in Baltimore City. The "Pro League" was, and still is, based on a draft selection method similar to ones used in other professional sports, and is the only League of its kind in the country.

For the first six years of the League's existence there were only 10 teams of 5 bowlers each, and expanded in the 1967-68 season to its present 12 team format.

Over the years the "Pro League's" schedule has varied in length from a 108 game season its first year to a high of 216 games for the 1964-65 through 1966-67 seasons, finally settling on its current 120 game schedule in 1977-78.

For several years in the beginning, teams had a "sixth man". These ten men were substitutes who were required to bowl each week on a separate pair of lanes from rest of the league to maintain an average.

Some other interesting notes on the formative years of the "Pro League"; the League charged admission to its matches, bowlers had to weigh their bowling balls in before each match and had to be in full uniform or they would not be allowed to bowl.

The Men's Division began its 31st season on August 25, 1991. The League has been supported by numerous commercial sponsors over the years, without whose support the league would not have been able to maintain the prestige of being the "Best League" in the area. CONDITIONS AND EQUIPMENT IMPACT DUCKPIN SCORES TREMENDOUSLY

The National Duckpin Bowling Congress first issued a national rankings list in 1929, but for reasons unknown did not show the bowlers averages until the 1933-34 season. At that time two Washington, D.C. bowlers, Joe Harrison with 124, and Lorraine Gulli with 117 were rated best in the country. However, Gulli's average was not representative of the top women as the number two average was only 109. She was in a class by herself.

The 1989-90 rankings list Kathy Boswell of N. Kingston, R.I. with 144 and Jon Owens of Sykesville, MD. with 153 as top ranked. These averages are at about the same level as they have been for recent years. Are today's bowlers really 30 pins a game better than the old timers, or has the game itself changed? There are some statistics from the early days which will scores have improved over the years.

The duckpin game originated in Baltimore about 1900 and spread to other areas a few years later. Some records in special matches during that time show that bowlers were scoring from 85 to 90 a game. Of course, these people were taking up a new game, but the balls then were about 4 3/4 inches in diameter and made of hard wood. The pins were some what smaller than the modern version. There is no record of other specifications, but it is said that the gutters were 4 inches deep and square instead of half round.

Add to all that the lack of lane maintenance, small houses with bare floors, incandescent lighting and fans for cooling. Perhaps 90 was a very good score after all. About 1910 the 5 inch ball came into use and the pins were made to near present specifications. The Washington City Duckpin Association was formed, and in their first annual tournament the winning team averaged about 107 per bowler overall.

Another dozen years and the best men were averaging 115 to 120, the top women 90 to 100. It is not known just when or why various conditions were changed, but the first NDBC specifications in 1934 allowed gutters to be half round, 2 1/2 half deep and 9 1/2 inches wide. The distance between side boards was 57 3/4 inches. Bowling balls were made of rubber or composition material and exact dimensions were specified for pins. As we have seen 124 and 117 conditions raised scores about thirty pins during the first 30 years of duckpin bowling.

During the next 20 years there were insignificant changes in lane specifications and only a minimal increase in averages. In 1955-56 two future Hall of Fame members led the nation, Jimmy Dietsch with 129 and Elizabeth "Toots" Barger with 120. Then the game began to change.

Many of today's bowlers have never seen a pinboy. They used to set the pins, which had a hole in the base, using a treadle to push steel pins up through holes in the pin plate to spot the

pins. They sat on a board atop the lane divider and cleared deadwood from either side as necessary. Balls were sent back on each side of the pair of lanes in use. Bowlers with personal balls had to carry them back and forth each frame.

In the mid 1950's Ken Sherman revolutionized the duckpin game by inventing the automatic pinsetting machine. In a few years almost every house had them installed. Free from dependence on the availability of pinboys, many modern duckpin centers were built, bringing many new bowlers into the game. However, there was one problem. Because of the necessary changes in pits and gutters to accommodate the machines, averages dropped several pins a game. During this same period the first plastic wood pins were introduced. They did not fall as well, causing a further drop in scores.

Bowlers howled in anguish. Something had to be done. After testing various ideas the NDBC changed specifications permitting gutters to be 1 inch in depth (they had been 2 inches for several years), and 7 1/2 inches in width. Several changes were made in the pits. Manufacturers improved the plastic coated pins and began to standardize their weight. The moves not only got back "lost scoring" but improved averages over pre-machine days. By 1963 Deitsch and Baltimore's Alva Brown were ranked on top with 133 and 125 respectively.

The game had stabilized, with uniform conditions and better scores than ever. Almost everyone one was satisfied with the status quo. However, some bowlers and some proprietors wanted still higher scores. This was nothing new. In the early days of the game a few operators who were also good bowlers are known to have sanded the lanes prior to a big match, in such a way as to create a kind of path into the pocket for the first ball. Opponents without this knowledge were at some disadvantage.

About 1950 someone thought a bigger pin would fall better. A few sets were made with the "belly" 3/16 inches larger in diameter. In a few special matches scores were not improved enough for the industry to scrap its supply of pins. An idea surfaced in the late 1950's to set pin on 11 inch centers instead of 12 inches. Several machines were modifed to test the idea. Again the small increase in scores did not justify the proposal. In 1961 came the wildest idea of all. It was proposed to change the scoring system to count a strike as an automatic 30 frame and spares would count for 20. If memory serves correctly a 10 frame would have counted as 15. Common sense prevailed and the plan struck out with no count.

In 1964 a New Englander suggested that sheets of tough rubber be glued to the fiber sideboards. This would improve "side action" and therefore scores, it would save wear on the pins and somewhat decrease noise levels. After testing, approved and scores jumped several pins a game. Two years later Jimmy Wolfensberger with 137 and Cathy Dyak with 129 set new records for ranking averages.

The last major change in specifications came in 1971 when the gutter depth was brought up to 1/2 inch, creating still more side

action of the pins. During that same period the first all plastic pins were approved. Early versions did not fall too well and it took the industry a couple of years to use up the other pins on hand. Later models scored as well of better and averages again improved. In 1973-74 Buddy Creamer began a three year run as the number one bowler, 142, 144 and 143 for ranking averages. The next year Cathy Dyak was back on top for women, remaining there for three years with averages of 133, 134 and 137.

In the next few years pins were structured to somewhat change the center of gravity. Pin decks were dropped to the maximum of 1/2 inch below the lane surface. These changes caused pins to move more horizontally than vertically, thereby increasing side action and also scores.

In 1978 Jeff Pyles had the first ranking average of 150 and set the record with 154 the next year. That same year Pat Rinaldi became the first woman with 140 for ranking average. During the last years men's ranking averages have been in the low 150's and women in the low 140's. Diane Jasper (Wirt) set the women's record with 147 in 1987.

We have seen averages go up about 60 pins during the 90 year history of duckpins, half that increase during the first 30 years of the game. The facts would indicate that materials, specifications and conditions have been primarily responsible for higher scores. Ray von Dreele, Astor Clarke, Nicky Tronsky, Lorraine Gulli, Ida Simmons, Katherine Vick; if these great bowlers were active today they surely would be in the same company as Deitsch, Volk and Lavers, Dyak, Rinaldi and Barger. All, past and present, have one thing in common. They are all members of the National Duckpin Bowling Congress Hall of Fame.

Editor's Note: The above paragraph completed the article which appeared in the Spring/Summer 1991 issue of "THE DUCKPIN NEWS". On the following page appears the career records of two Baltimore Professional Duckpin Association Hall of Fame members, Dave Volk and Jim Vest. Note that Volk's career started in 1961-62 and Vest's in 1979-80. To make the comparison more intriguing is the fact that both bowlers are left-handed and that this is not a lefty-righty comparison. The charts cover a 12 year period for each bowler, Volk's entire career in the BPDA and Vest's record to date. I leave up to the reader to decide "WHO IS BETTER?".

As a further illustration as to how conditions and equipment have increased scoring in duckpins, the last page of this book contains the Final Standings and Average Sheet from the first year of the BPDA, 1961-62. Those great bowlers from the past would not even have qualified for the "Pro League" draft today, had they had to use their averages from that season.

CONDITIONS AND EQUIPMENT IMPACT DUCKPIN SCORES TREMENDOUSLY

The National Duckpin Bowling Congress first issued a national rankings list in 1929, but for reasons unknown did not show the bowlers averages until the 1933-34 season. At that time two Washington, D.C. bowlers, Joe Harrison with 124, and Lorraine Gulli with 117 were rated best in the country. However, Gulli's average was not representative of the top women as the number two average was only 109. She was in a class by herself.

The 1989-90 rankings list Kathy Boswell of N. Kingston, R.I. with 144 and Jon Owens of Sykesville, MD. with 153 as top ranked. These averages are at about the same level as they have been for recent years. Are today's bowlers really 30 pins a game better than the old timers, or has the game itself changed? There are some statistics from the early days which will scores have improved over the years.

The duckpin game originated in Baltimore about 1900 and spread to other areas a few years later. Some records in special matches during that time show that bowlers were scoring from 85 to 90 a game. Of course, these people were taking up a new game, but the balls then were about 4 3/4 inches in diameter and made of hard wood. The pins were some what smaller than the modern version. There is no record of other specifications, but it is said that the gutters were 4 inches deep and square instead of half round.

Add to all that the lack of lane maintenance, small houses with bare floors, incandescent lighting and fans for cooling. Perhaps 90 was a very good score after all. About 1910 the 5 inch ball came into use and the pins were made to near present specifications. The Washington City Duckpin Association was formed, and in their first annual tournament the winning team averaged about 107 per bowler overall.

Another dozen years and the best men were averaging 115 to 120, the top women 90 to 100. It is not known just when or why various conditions were changed, but the first NDBC specifications in 1934 allowed gutters to be half round, 2 1/2 half deep and 9 1/2 inches wide. The distance between side boards was 57 3/4 inches. Bowling balls were made of rubber or composition material and exact dimensions were specified for pins. As we have seen 124 and 117 conditions raised scores about thirty pins during the first 30 years of duckpin bowling.

During the next 20 years there were insignificant changes in lane specifications and only a minimal increase in averages. In 1955-56 two future Hall of Fame members led the nation, Jimmy Dietsch with 129 and Elizabeth "Toots" Barger with 120. Then the game began to change.

Many of today's bowlers have never seen a pinboy. They used to set the pins, which had a hole in the base, using a treadle to push steel pins up through holes in the pin plate to spot the

pins. They sat on a board atop the lane divider and cleared deadwood from either side as necessary. Balls were sent back on each side of the pair of lanes in use. Bowlers with personal balls had to carry them back and forth each frame.

In the mid 1950's Ken Sherman revolutionized the duckpin game by inventing the automatic pinsetting machine. In a few years almost every house had them installed. Free from dependence on the availability of pinboys, many modern duckpin centers were built, bringing many new bowlers into the game. However, there was one problem. Because of the necessary changes in pits and gutters to accommodate the machines, averages dropped several pins a game. During this same period the first plastic wood pins were introduced. They did not fall as well, causing a further drop in scores.

Bowlers howled in anguish. Something had to be done. After testing various ideas the NDBC changed specifications permitting gutters to be 1 inch in depth (they had been 2 inches for several years), and 7 1/2 inches in width. Several changes were made in the pits. Manufacturers improved the plastic coated pins and began to standardize their weight. The moves not only got back "lost scoring" but improved averages over pre-machine days. By 1963 Deitsch and Baltimore's Alva Brown were ranked on top with 133 and 125 respectively.

The game had stabilized, with uniform conditions and better scores than ever. Almost everyone one was satisfied with the status quo. However, some bowlers and some proprietors wanted still higher scores. This was nothing new. In the early days of the game a few operators who were also good bowlers are known to have sanded the lanes prior to a big match, in such a way as to create a kind of path into the pocket for the first ball. Opponents without this knowledge were at some disadvantage.

About 1950 someone thought a bigger pin would fall better. A few sets were made with the "belly" 3/16 inches larger in diameter. In a few special matches scores were not improved enough for the industry to scrap its supply of pins. An idea surfaced in the late 1950's to set pin on 11 inch centers instead of 12 inches. Several machines were modifed to test the idea. Again the small increase in scores did not justify the proposal. In 1961 came the wildest idea of all. It was proposed to change the scoring system to count a strike as an automatic 30 frame and spares would count for 20. If memory serves correctly a 10 frame would have counted as 15. Common sense prevailed and the plan struck out with no count.

In 1964 a New Englander suggested that sheets of tough rubber be glued to the fiber sideboards. This would improve "side action" and therefore scores, it would save wear on the pins and somewhat decrease noise levels. After testing, approved and scores jumped several pins a game. Two years later Jimmy Wolfensberger with 137 and Cathy Dyak with 129 set new records for ranking averages.

The last major change in specifications came in 1971 when the gutter depth was brought up to 1/2 inch, creating still more side

action of the pins. During that same period the first all plastic pins were approved. Early versions did not fall too well and it took the industry a couple of years to use up the other pins on hand. Later models scored as well of better and averages again improved. In 1973-74 Buddy Creamer began a three year run as the number one bowler, 142, 144 and 143 for ranking averages. The next year Cathy Dyak was back on top for women, remaining there for three years with averages of 133, 134 and 137.

In the next few years pins were structured to somewhat change the center of gravity. Pin decks were dropped to the maximum of 1/2 inch below the lane surface. These changes caused pins to move more horizontally than vertically, thereby increasing side action and also scores.

In 1978 Jeff Pyles had the first ranking average of 150 and set the record with 154 the next year. That same year Pat Rinaldi became the first woman with 140 for ranking average. During the last years men's ranking averages have been in the low 150's and women in the low 140's. Diane Jasper (Wirt) set the women's record with 147 in 1987.

We have seen averages go up about 60 pins during the 90 year history of duckpins, half that increase during the first 30 years of the game. The facts would indicate that materials, specifications and conditions have been primarily responsible for higher scores. Ray von Dreele, Astor Clarke, Nicky Tronsky, Lorraine Gulli, Ida Simmons, Katherine Vick; if these great bowlers were active today they surely would be in the same company as Deitsch, Volk and Lavers, Dyak, Rinaldi and Barger. All, past and present, have one thing in common. They are all members of the National Duckpin Bowling Congress Hall of Fame.

Editor's Note: The above paragraph completed the article which appeared in the Spring/Summer 1991 issue of "THE DUCKPIN NEWS". On the following page appears the career records of two Baltimore Professional Duckpin Association Hall of Fame members, Dave Volk and Jim Vest. Note that Volk's career started in 1961-62 and Vest's in 1979-80. To make the comparison more intriguing is the fact that both bowlers are left-handed and that this is not a lefty-righty comparison. The charts cover a 12 year period for each bowler, Volk's entire career in the BPDA and Vest's record to date. I leave up to the reader to decide "WHO IS BETTER?".

As a further illustration as to how conditions and equipment have increased scoring in duckpins, the last page of this book contains the Final Standings and Average Sheet from the first year of the BPDA, 1961-62. Those great bowlers from the past would not even have qualified for the "Pro League" draft today, had they had to use their averages from that season.
